If you observe that the racking system in your warehouse needs to be changed or adjusted so that you are able to accommodate a higher quantity of goods, then you need to do it immediately.



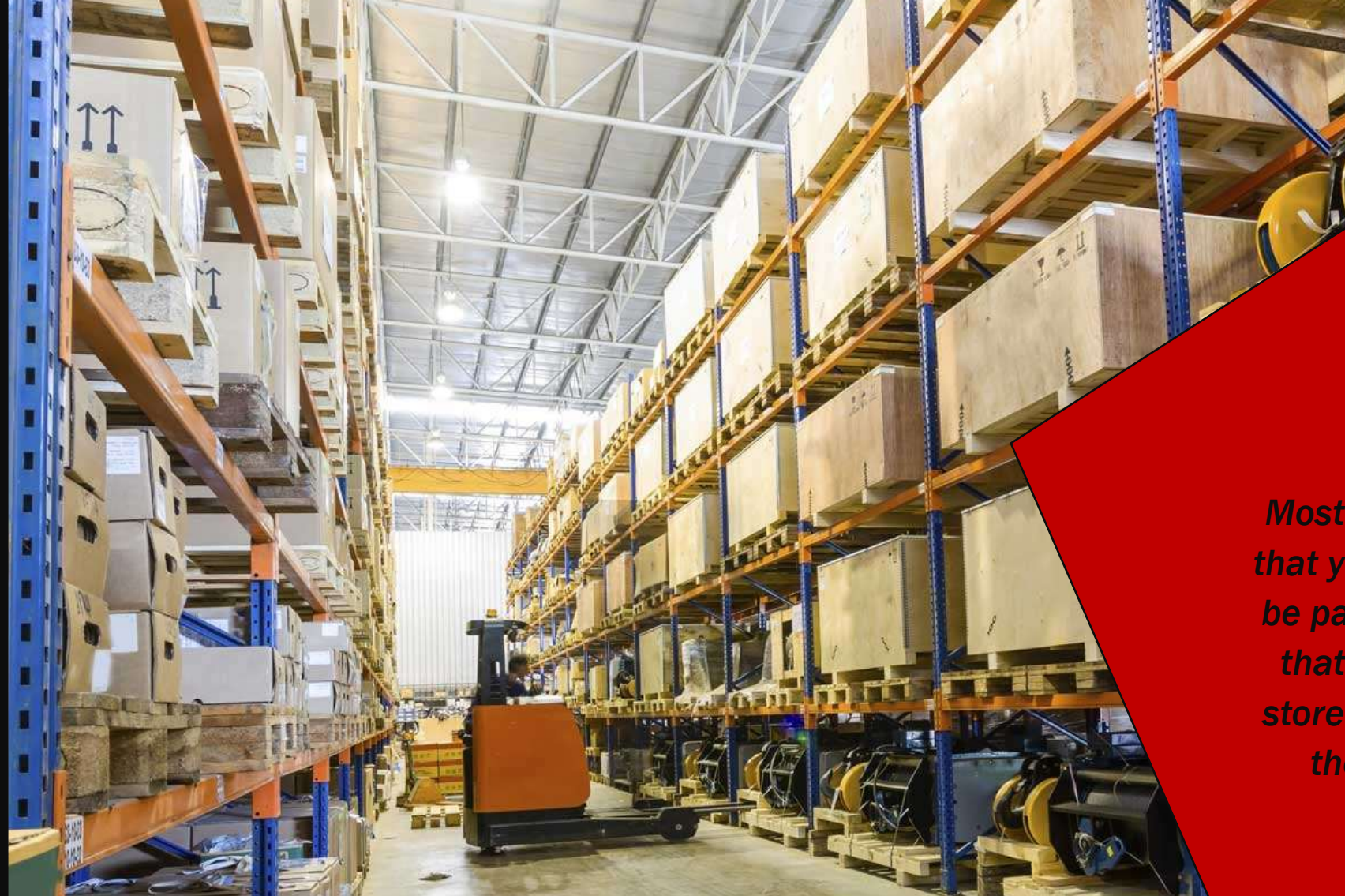
Also by changing the racking system, you will have the opportunity to use more vertical space to increase your total storage capacity.

materials
properly*



The way you pack and store the items on your shelves also determines the availability of space in your warehouse.



Most of the time the goods that you will receive will not be packaged which means that they are going to be stored in a container while they are kept at your warehouse.



While some materials need to be stored in large containers because of their size but there are other materials that are unnecessarily stored in large containers.



Consequently, you can also use bulk bags for the packing and storage of materials in your warehouse because bulk bags are very convenient for the storage of goods as they increase the amount of vertical space.
